REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR
General Report
ED Russo spoke about various changes suggested by the sub-committee in connection with the State Specific Land Surveying examination. On a motion by BM Vernick, second by BM Angeline, the Board voted unanimously to accept the changes to the examination.

Incoming Correspondence

Michael Stossel (BM Marshall to report) RE: On-line course (December 2, 2004)

Mr. Stossel requests review of a particular course offered through Kennedy-Western University via the Internet.

The Board reviewed Mr. Stossel's request and determined that this course does not meet requirements and is not ABET accredited. The Board, on a motion by BM Marshall, second by BM Vernick, unanimously voted to inform him that this course is not acceptable. However, the Board will inform him that Excelsior College, a distance learning academic institution in New York State, is an ABET accredited institution that provides Internet courses.

Thomas J. Bowen, Bureau of Coastal & Land Use Enforcement/ NJ Department of Environmental Protection RE: Freshwater Wetland Protection Act (January 19, 2005)

Mr. Bowen advises that he is available to discuss this matter as it pertains to professional engineers.

Louis F. Correale, Sr. REHS/ Rockaway Township RE: Professional engineers and topographies relating to site plan designs (January 12, 2005)

Elyssa Loiacono, Environmental Health Specialist/ Washington Township Health Department RE: Professional engineers and topography as it relates to septic systems (January 19, 2005)

Ms. Loiacono requests the Board's interpretation as to whether a new topographic survey must be prepared for design of a failing septic system.

The Board will provide Ms. Loiacono with a copy of the notice from the New Jersey Register.
