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CALL TO ORDER

Elizabeth Greenblatt, Regulatory Analyst, appeared before the Board for a discussion on the proposed amendment to N.J.A.C.13:40-13.5 to include a biennial renewal period for Board approved providers of engineer CPC courses.

The Board on a motion by VP Purcell, second by BM Jones, voted to approve the

proposed amendment to <u>N.J.A.C</u>.13:40-13.5(a) to include the following two sentences at the end of paragraph:

"This approval shall be valid only for the biennial licensing period as indicated by the Board. A provider seeking approval for a subsequent biennial licensing period shall submit a new application for approval."

In addition, the Board's web page is to be updated with a notification of the pending changes.

Elizabeth Greenblatt discussed:

<u>A3694</u> - Grants immunity from liability for certain professional services rendered during emergencies under certain circumstances. The Board on a motion by BM Smith, second by BM Cleary, voted to support this bill with the addition of professional land surveyors to the proposal.

Additionally, the Board on a motion by BM Jones, second by BM Valenti, voted to approve the Home Inspection proposal to increase the number of continuing education units from ten (10) to twenty (20) for correspondence, Internet, or other distance learning courses approved by the Home Inspection Advisory Committee.
