The Board noted the February 16, 2012 minutes for the record.

After reviewing the minutes of March 15, 2012, the Board on a motion by VP Schwartz. second by BM Purcell, voted to approve these minutes as amended.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

General Report

Acting Executive Director, Ray, discussed with the Board his prior experience with developing the verification of immigration status initiative.

On a motion by BM Jones, second by BM Smith, the Board voted to approve the Invoice for \$250.00 from the Colonial States Boards of Surveyor Registration for 2012.

Acting Executive Director, Ray, informed the Board that added support to assist the staff may have contributed to the return of damaged Wall Certificates of new licensee's.

On a motion by BM Purcell, second by VP Schwartz, the voted to approve the Application for Reinstatement, Reactivation and Resumption of Practice with changes. Experience listed on pages #2 and #8 will be combined into one section. Additionally, the instructions will be revised to request experience only since the last renewal period involved.

Acting Executive Director, Ray, informed the Board that responses to the "Ask Consumer Affairs" E-Mails received, is now current, as a result of the support of the Staff. Six hundred (600) responses were sent since the last meeting.

BM Jones spoke about the deficiencies in on-line courses provided for professional land surveyors, and concluded to request that each of the approved sponsors listed on the Board's web page, provide copies of documents regarding their responsibilities of program providers pursuant to N.J.A.C.13:40-11.12.

BM Smith requested that the land surveyor application be updated and that the land surveyor-in-training reference form be added to the Board's website.

The Board requested that the process for reviewing continuing professional competency course providers be developed in advance of its regulation being adopted.

INCOMING CORRESPONDENCE

Rubin M. Zallen, PE March 9, 2012

Re: Request for a Waiver from Continuing Professional Credits

The Board discussed this request and on a motion by VP Schwartz, second by BM Purcell, voted to accept Mr. Zallen's 8 continuing professional credits already taken for this period, and to possibly waive an additional 7 CPC credits for medical reasons. Mr. Zallen will also be advised that he will be required to complete 24 CPC credits during the next renewal period unless he requests a medical waiver therefrom.

The Board also determined that going forward, the standard practice should be to send a letter to all those asking for a medical waiver and to request proof of their condition.

Re: Concern regarding the CPC requirements posted on the Board's website.

The Board discussed Mr. Chapman's concern regarding the conclusion he reached after reading the Board's website Notice, concerning its continuing professional competency requirements. In addition, the Board concluded that public entity bid documents must be signed and sealed by an Engineer, and to advise Mr. Burke that it is acceptable for bid documents to be unsigned and unsealed for the purposes of bidding, with the format to be determined by the agencies, but that construction documents must be signed and sealed.

Re: A 1545 - Revises law concerning certain professional and occupational licenses.

Ms. Greenblatt appeared before the Board to discuss the proposed law referenced above. A 1545 removes the 5 year rule, eliminates taking the exam, making it standard with a number of fee's, including establishing proof for continuing education, only for the renewal period involved be limited to 30. The Board discussed this matter and on a motion by BM Purcell, second by VP Schwartz, voted to support it. BP Valenti opposed.
