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# STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS Minutes of May 17, 2012 Public Session

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting of the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was called to order by Board President, Perry Schwartz, at 9:00 a.m. at 124 Halsey Street, 3rd Floor, Union Conference Room, Newark, New Jersey. #### Appearance - Elizabeth Greenblatt, Regulatory Analyst

Re: Waiver Rule - Performance Based Outcomes <u>N.J.A.C</u>.13:45C-2 and 3. This was noted for the record.

Re: Bill #A2882 - Requires professional boards to provide waivers or exemptions from their requirements for licensure for veterans with substantially equivalent training. #### REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

#### **General Report**

Acting Executive Director, Ray, informed the Board that the Board's website has been updated regarding its professional competency requirements.

BM Smith requested the Board to remove the Map Filing Law from the website and replace it with the public version of the Title Recordation Act.

BM Purcell requested the Board to remove the approved Continuing Education list's for May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2012, for both professional engineers and professional land surveyors.

Acting Executive Director, Ray, informed the Board that the approved providers for the land surveying continuing education courses, have provided copies of documents regarding their responsibilities as program providers pursuant to N.J.A.C.13:40-11.12.

Acting Executive Director, Ray informed the Board that a one year contract extension (T-2632), with Professional Credentials Services, has been executed. An additional one year contract extension remains available.

The Board reviewed NCEES' Notice of future changes to its examinations and supporting materials and noted it for the record.

On a motion by VP Purcell, second by BM Frantz, the Board voted to approve BM Smith to attend the 91<sup>st</sup> NCEES Annual Meeting in St. Louis, MO on August 22-25, 2012 as the funded delegate.

The Board re-reviewed Mr. Sheta's request for a waiver of the fundamentals of engineering examination. Previously, the Board granted him thirteen (13) years of credited experience toward the requisite minimum fifteen (15) years required. Mr. Sheta requested that two years additional credit toward the waiver, be given for his master's and doctorate degrees from Cairo University. The Board denied this request. However, Mr. Sheta will be advised that if he is able to independently verify that his two advanced degrees, which were not evaluated by CPEES, nor part of his overall academic assessment, are equivalent to two graduate degrees earned from the United States, the Board would consider revisiting his request for a waiver from taking the fundamentals of engineering examination.
