DISCUSSION ITEM

Educational Requirements

The Board held a discussion regarding the matter of additional education as a requirement for licensure as a professional engineer. There has been general discussion in the engineering community sponsored by the ASCE, of changing the current education requirement of a Bachelor's degree in engineering by adding a Masters degree or, an additional 30 credit hours of graduate work to sit for the Principles & Practices of Engineering examination.

Recognizing there is not any pending legislation in the State of New Jersey to change the education requirement, the Board discussed the merits of additional education and limitations of doing so beyond the requirement of graduation from a Board approved curriculum in engineering or engineering technology as set forth in N.J.S.A. 45:8-35. At the current time the Board was of the general opinion it does not support the need to increase the education requirement for licensure as a professional engineer. The Board has not observed a significant volume of complaints filed against licensees based upon a lack of competency in their academic training. Thus, it does not appear that the consumers in the State of New Jersey are being harmed or damaged as a result of its current education law set forth in N.J.S.A. 45:8-35.

The Board was also concerned with the potential adverse impact such a proposal may have in the quantity of engineers to meet the needs of the profession in the State of New Jersey. The Board was of the general opinion that the current education requirement appears adequate for individuals to function at the level necessary to pursue licensure and to protect consumers in the state. Further, the Board noted that many licensees pursue additional education and degrees as appropriate to gain higher skill levels in particular disciplines such as transportation, structural or environmental engineering.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Charles Blumeling, PE/PLS requested additional information relative to a complaint filed with the Home Inspection Advisory Committee against a home inspector who is also licensed as a professional engineer. The Board advised Mr. Blumeling to speak with the Home Inspection Advisory Committee regarding this matter.

MOVE TO EXECUTIVE SESSION

On a motion by BM Valenti, second by BM Koo, the Board unanimously voted to enter into Executive Session to review disciplinary matters.

RETURN TO PUBLIC

On a motion contained within the Executive Session minutes, the Board re-entered into Public Session to adjourn.

ADJOURNMENT

On motion by BM Frantz, second by BM Marshall, the Board unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 2:20pm.
