# CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was called to order by Board President James Valenti at 9:00 a.m. at 124 Halsey Street, 3rd Floor Union Conference Room, Newark, New Jersey. All parties were duly notified of the time, date and place, with all pertinent material being provided.

#### SUNSHINE LAW ANNOUNCEMENT

Board President Valenti read the statement required by Chapter 231, Laws of 1975 known as the Open Public Meetings Act, and announced that notice of this meeting was prepared in the office of the Board and mailed to the Secretary of State, the Newark Star Ledger, Trenton Times, the Camden Courier Post, Bergen Record, and the Atlantic City Press.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Legislation

BM Vernick updated the Board on the following bill:

A1824/S136 - Requirements for licensure as a land surveyor. This bill was withdrawn. Joint Committee

BP Valenti reported that the Joint Committee meeting was cancelled due to a lack of agenda items.

Contract Renewal Committee

On a motion by BM Schwartz, second by BM Marshall, the Board voted to send a notice to David Szuchman, Director, expressing its concerns regarding issues on the contract waiver/extension for the October 2008 examination, the public bidding of the new contract and the contract for the April 2009 examination.

# ARE Review Committee

At its September 4, 2008 meeting, the Board voted to take the position that the divisions entitled "plans and programing practice" and "construction document division services" are not related to site and building design as required by the statute.

VP Purcell advised the Board that the Board's determination had been memorialized in writing and provided to the regulatory analyst.

# REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

General Report

ED Russo informed the Board that the principles and practices examinations will be conducted on Friday, October 24, 2008 and the fundamentals examinations will be conducted on Saturday, October 25, 2008. He also reported that the exams will be held at the West Trenton and NJIT sites.

The Board requested that the website posting of the Certificate of Authorization notice be revised to remove the last paragraph in order to accurately reflect that the renewal period had not been extended.

The Board discussed the signing and sealing of documents as required by the NJDEP and on a motion by BM Vernick, second by BM Angeline, concluded that all original documents submitted must be manually signed and that all documents must contain a raised seal.
