The Board, on a motion by BM Raimondi, second by BM Marshall, unanimously approved the minutes of June 15, 2006 as submitted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Legislation

A3247 - Transfers powers of Landscape Architect Examination & Evaluation Committee to New Jersey State Board of Architects - The Board reviewed this pending legislation and, on a motion by BM Cleary, second by BM Raimondi, unanimously voted in support of this bill as long as there would not be a decrease in the scope of services provided by professional engineers or an increase in the scope of services provided by certified landscape architects. Finally, the Board requested that the proposed legislation clearly state that professional engineers may continue to provide landscape architecture services.

A3213 - Affords homeowners impartial inspections and assistance when repairs are made to new homes - The Board reviewed this legislation and, on a motion by BM Frantz, second by BM Cleary, unanimously voted to support this bill provided the term "licensed engineer" be changed to "licensed professional engineer."

S2167 - Requires licensed home inspector to report an energy rating for each home inspected for buyer in contemplation of purchase - The Board, on a motion by BM Marshall, second by BM Kelly, unanimously

The Board will advise Mr. Lips that any course that is ABET accredited would satisfy the Board's licensure requirements. If not ABET accredited, then the Board would evaluate the program during the application process.

The Board discussed the possible acceptance of academic institutions within the Washington Accord Treaty as the equivalent of an ABET accredited institution. After further discussion the Board concluded that all applicants with foreign degrees, including those degrees from Washington Accord member nations, must have their degrees evaluated by a Board approved evaluation service to determine compliance with its minimum education standards.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Charles Blumeling, PE, PLS, informed the Board that today's agenda was not posted on its website. He informed the Board that the name of a certain home inspection company may provide consumers with the impression that it is a better than others and wishes the Board to investigate this matter. The Board advised Mr. Blumeling to contact the Committee or Division's Ethics Officer, Robert Campenelli, on this matter.

In addition, Mr. Blumeling stated that based upon A3247 he would like to see the engineering profession retain its ability to render landscaping services. He further stated that S2167 will cause problems for home inspectors since their training curriculum does not cover energy audit procedures and that additional education would be needed to offer this service.

On a motion by BM Valenti, second by BM Koo, the Board unanimously voted to enter into Executive Session to review disciplinary matters.
