RE: Corner Marker Regulation Amendments  
(September 13, 2005)

Mr. Campbell asked various questions regarding the setting of corner markers when constructing or repairing a septic system, as-built locations to obtain a final site plan approval from a Planning or Zoning Board or allowing an attorney to sign on behalf of clients.

The Board reviewed this matter and shall advise Mr. Campbell that N.J.A.C. 13:40-5.1 and 5.2 appears to apply, which requires that corners markers be set unless a proper waiver has been obtained from the ultimate user as set forth in the regulation.
