STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS Minutes of December 15, 2011 Public Session

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was called to order by Board President, James K. Valenti, at 9:00 a.m. at 124 Halsey Street, 3rd Floor, Union Conference Room, Newark, New Jersey. All parties were duly notified of the time, date and place, with all pertinent material being provided.

After reviewing the minutes of November 17, 2011, the Board on a motion by VP Schwartz, second by BM Jones, voted to approve these minutes as amended.

APPEARANCES

Elizabeth Greenblatt, Regulatory Analyst

Ms. Greenblatt appeared before the Board to discuss S2271, which requires the owner of a building advised of structural safety concern discovered during a private inspection to notify the municipal code official and the DCA. It also requires the DCA to schedule an emergency inspection of that municipal dwelling within 24 hours. Failure to provide such report shall be deemed professional misconduct without a hearing before this Board.

The Board agreed that this proposed practice does not comport with how it operates and that it cannot be bound by another Agency. On a motion by BM Purcell, second by BM Vernick, the Board voted to request the removal of the last sentence regarding professional misconduct, quoted in 1(b) of the bill.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Acting Executive Director, Joseph Grabowy reviewed the Fiscal Year 2011, final budget Report, which was noted for the record. Overall, the Board's finances are in sound fiscal condition.
