# STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS Minutes of December 18, 2008

#### CALL TO ORDER

BMs Schwartz and Frantz will draft a letter to the

DOE acknowledging the Board's support of the STEP program and its willingness to make a presentation to the United Federation of Teachers.

Patrick Fatton, Vice-President, representing the NJSPLS, indicated that its comment to A-3361 (Map Filing Law Bill) is not yet available. Mr. Fatton also informed the Board of a program entitled the "National Trig Star," that reviews the trigonometry test for high school students.
