3.) INQUIRY - MATT GLENNON- email dated May 25, 2016 "What if any license is required for a contractor installing "cured in place pipe" liners (CIPP) to repair damaged underground sewer drain lines ... et al"

On June 23, 2016, the Board discussed this matter and concluded that this type of material (CIPP) is generally installed for sewer lines. The Board referred Mr. Glennon to existing New Jersey Plumbing Statutes and Regulations, with respect to tasks that require a Licensed Master Plumber, and include the interior of the building, specifically N.J.AC. 13:32-1.3 DEFINITIONS:

"Plumbing" also means the practice and materials used in the installation, maintenance, extension, alteration, repair or removal of storm water, refrigeration and air conditioning drains, liquid waste or sewage. "Plumbing" does not include the final connection to an approved point of disposal or an approved supply system which extends beyond three feet of a building or structure.

This matter was reviewed at the recent June 7, 2016 HVACR meeting and the revised language was forwarded to the State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers for consideration.

"Master HVACR Contractors may discharge condensate lines into an indirect waste with an appropriate air gap or air break to an approved sanitary or storm drain system."
