- 4. 2024 Meeting Dates: In accordance with the Committee's statues, the must hold a minimum of 2 meetings per calendar year. Per the Division of Law, due to the Deputy Attorney General's reorganization schedule, the Division has designated Fridays as its day to hold the Committee's monthly meetings for 2024.
- 5. The Ethics and Compliance Officer Francine Widrich will be providing Ethics Training during the Committee's next available meeting. All members of the Committee will be required to attend.
- 6. In promulgating the Committee's regulations, the Regulatory Subcommittee members and its Regulatory Analyst's is asking the full Committee's to review and discuss the areas of concerns:
  - The subcommittee estimated that there will be roughly 5,000 individuals who obtain licensure as a pool and spa builder and installer or as a pool and spa service contractor. Of these 5,000, how many will be licensed as builders and installers? How many will be service contractors?
  - 2. The qualification to become licensed as a pool and spa builder and installer is certification as a PHTA Certified Building Professional (CBP). This certification is also one of the qualifications to become licensed as a pool and spa service contractor. Will the Committee require a licensee to hold both licenses in order to perform both services? Would this apply only for those who hold the CBP certification?
  - 3. N.J.S.A. 45:5A-42 prohibits any person form engaging in pool and spa service contracting or pool and spa building and installation unless that person has satisfied the requirements of the Act. N.J.S.A. 45:5A-48

imposes identification requirements on licensees and "every employee or other person engaged in the unsupervised building, servicing, or maintenance of a pool". Does this provision authorize subcontractors to provide services associated with pool building and installation or do such subcontractors have to obtain a license to satisfy N.J.S.A. 45:5A-42?
