III. REVIEW OF MINUTES

April 7, 2004 - Upon motion made by Dr. Jerry Rosenberg and seconded by Dr. Delores Johnson the Committee voted to approve the minutes with corrections. A change was made as follows: Page 2, Review of Regulations and Application Section, line 7, to delete the reference to the "American Board of Professional Psychology" and insert a reference to the "American Board for Accreditation in Psychoanalysis, Inc." All voted in favor of the motion.

IV. PUBLIC COMMENT

No members from the public were present.

V. CERTIFICATION MATTERS

Application for Certification

Committee members further reviewed a draft copy of the Application for Certification as a Psychoanalyst. It was noted that Section 4 regarding Citizenship/ Immigration Status, should be updated to reflect the current name of the Division of the Department of Homeland Security formerly known as the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services (BCIS). As that entity is now known as the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (U.S.C.I.S.), that information was added to the application form. In addition, Section 4, line 3 was amended to include a copy of the applicant's current Form I-94. Line 9, referencing (B.C.I.S.) also changed to (U.S.C.I.S.).

VI. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director Elaine DeMars explained to the Committee members that the Division of Law billing represents a budget report from Administration regarding the first quarter of the year 2005. She further discussed the Fiscal Year 2004 Budget Report and how the Committee will be required to reimburse Treasury for its funding once fees for certification are collected. She also informed the Committee that there are current travel restrictions, which apply to the Division of Consumer Affairs and other state agencies, that were issued by the Governor's office in late December 2004.

VII. LEGISLATIVE /REGULATIONS

- A) New York Proposed Promulgation of Regulations of the Commissioner of Education Relating to Requirements for Licensure in Psychoanalysis- DAG Brown discussed the administrative rulemaking process undertaken by New York State in proposing and adopting rules for the practice of psychoanalysis.
- B) Senate Bill-1930 Revises procedures for suspension or revocation of licenses for overdue child support- The Committee members reviewed this as informational and did not have any comments on that Senate Bill.
- C) Assembly Bill -3757 Revises licensure and certification requirements for certain persons who engage in practice of social work- Executive Director, Elaine DeMars, explained to the committee members that this bill was created to protect the consumer utilizing social work services in certain agencies that are currently exempt settings.. All voted in favor of the Bill.
- D) Senate Bill- 2321 Requires conditionally discharged drug dependent persons to undergo assessment and drug treatment- The Committee expressed a concern that psychoanalytic services should be included as a method of treatment for drug dependent persons.
